Program Description:

This program is designed to prepare students for employment as a Nurse

Assistant in a variety of settings. Students will learn patient care, observation, and communication skills with an emphasis on caring for the geriatric resident in a long-term care facility. The program prepares students to be successful in the workplace by teaching employability skills and modeling workplace expectations. The program includes both classroom in person instruction (theory) and 100 clinical hours. Students will take the CA state licensure exam at the end of the program.

Applications must be submitted online at cry-rop.org, students, programs, scroll to the bottom of the page to after-school programs, click on and complete application. Make sure to answer each question with more than a yes/no answer.

Prerequisite:

- Students who are Juniors and Seniors are invited to apply to attend the program.
- This is a competitive process. Students must complete the application and the highest scoring students will be selected.
- Students must have completed a medical pathway program prior to enrolling into this program & earned a
 grade of B or better.
- Students must have current, legal ID & original Social Security Card or right to work document (Original cards are required)
- Students are required to show proof of a current physical, TB screening, annual flu shot and COVID-19 vaccination(s).
- Students must provide a pair of white or black athletic type shoes that won't penetrate liquid.
- Students will need to purchase class uniforms (uniforms available for \$35 per set).
