Are you interested in working in the Healthcare Field starting at \$17-\$20 per hour? CRY-ROP is offering an Afterschool & Saturday program

Program Description:

This program is designed to prepare students for employment as a Nurse Assistant in a variety of settings. Students will learn patient



care, observation, and communication skills with an emphasis on caring for the geriatric resident in a longterm care facility. The program prepares students to be successful in the workplace by teaching employability skills and modeling workplace expectations. The program includes both classroom in person instruction (theory) and 100 clinical hours. Students will take the state certification exam at the end of the program.

Applications can be submitted starting 1/09/2024 online at cry-rop.org, students, classes and then scroll down to the bottom of the page to after school classes, then complete the application.

Prerequisite:

- Students who are Juniors and Seniors are invited to apply to attend the program.
- This is a competitive process. Students must complete the application and the highest scoring students will be selected.
- Students must have current, legal ID & original Social Security Card (Original cards are required)
- Students will need a physical, TB screening, seasonal flu shot and COVID-19 vaccination(s).
- Students must provide a pair of white or black shoes that won't penetrate liquid.
- Students will need to purchase class uniforms (uniforms available for \$35 per set).
