

NURSING ASSISTANT-CERTIFIED HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAM at RUSD DUE DATES & PROGRAM INFORMATION SPRING 2024

We are offering a Nurse Assistant-Certified program this spring at Redlands High School. Any Redlands Unified School District Junior or Senior may attend who have passed a medical pathway program with a B or better. Program dates for spring: January 29-May 16, 2024

- Classes meet Monday, Tuesday, and Thursdays from 4:00pm-8:00pm and five scheduled Saturdays from 7:30am-4:00pm.
- Theory classes are in person at Redlands High School, Room 73 and clinicals will take place at a local long-term healthcare facility. CPR training is held at the ROP main site in Redlands.

Important Dates for the Nurse Assistant- Certified RUSD Fall class:



- 01/24/24 Deadline to submit Application (Must be complete to be considered into the program). Submit before 3:00pm.
- 01/26/24 All students selected to the program or placed on the waitlist will be contacted by email. Watch for emails. Once contacted, registration instructions will be given.
- 01/24-29/24 Students complete the on-line registration process by completing the forms emailed by the Student Services-Registration office. The emails sent will say they are from the "Orbund Admin" which is part of our Student Information System.
- 01/25/24 at 6:00pm Mandatory Student/Parent or Guardian Orientation Meeting. Each student must attend an Orientation meeting with their parent or guardian. Meetings will be held via zoom. Link will be provided in acceptance letter.
- 02/16/24 **Physicals, TB results, season flu shot, and verification of COVID vaccinations and boosters must** be submitted to teacher by 02/08/2024. A declination can be signed if the student has a religious or medical reason for non-COVID vaccination.

Things to Remember:

- Students must have a current, legal ID and original social security card or right to work document upon entering the program.
- Students are required to maintain 70% class performance and 93% class attendance.
- To sit for the state exam, **all students** must complete a minimum of 100 clinical hours and have a passing grade of a C- or better.
- Students must have regular attendance in class.
- Students must purchase their own uniforms. Uniforms can be purchased for \$35 a set from CRY-ROP. Uniforms will be available for purchase the first week of class. We require the following uniform: Cherokee Workman Uniforms. Students are required to wear black bottoms and a blue top. The color of the top is called CIEL or CIEW (It is a shade of a lighter blue). No alternate variations of the top or bottom will be allowed. No striping or other colors on uniform.
